Dear Parent/Carers,

School Parking

The purpose of this letter is to ask for your cooperation and assistance in managing a worrying situation that is causing widespread concern for ourselves and parents and carers of children at the school.

We have become increasingly concerned at the dangers being posed to your children in the areas around the school. Vehicles being parked illegally or in dangerous positions, and vehicles being driven at excess speed or carelessly in the areas around the school, are putting your children at very real danger of being involved in an accident and being injured.

We have consulted with the local Police Community Safety Unit and as a result have decided that the first step should be a plea to yourselves to assist us by trying to be more aware and considerate when parking and picking up your children. This includes double parking, stopping on approaches to crossings, excess speed around the school pick up areas, parking unlawfully and generally trying to be more aware of the children entering and exiting the school and what poses a risk to them.

In discussion with Medway Police we have agreed a series of steps to be taken if we identify repeat offenders which could ultimately result in prosecution but clearly it would be far more preferable to be able to improve the safety of our children with your support rather than have to address it via that route.
